Breswick, 13098803, DD 4566 00218, due to the fact that the fragments of bones are so small, it is impracticable to attempt to resolve this case at the present time. However, Dr. Snow, the Anthropologist, advised me that it is apparent that there are portions of at least two (2) remains in this casket. The Office of The Quartermaster General will be advised at a later date as to the outcome of this case. In the case of Orrin W. Thorson, 0-773887, DD 4566 02106, further investigation reveals that there was absolutely no evidence of any remains being interred. I personally viewed the remains, or rather, what was reported to be the remains, and there was nothing in the casket but small pieces of concrete which had been broken up at the laboratory in search of any trace of the remains. Dr. Snow advised me that there was no evidence to indicate that any remains had been interred in this case. There was a question as to whether the glove found in the casket was that of a man or a woman. Mr. William A. McNanamy, Embalmer, stated that he personally opened the wooden box in this case when disinterred at Schofield Cemetery and that it contained only sawdust and three (3) pieces of cement. He further stated that the sawdust was thoroughly screened and that nothing was found to indicate that any remains had been in the box. Inquiry reveals that the personnel connected with the original interment at Schoffeld Country longer on duty in this Theater. RESTRICTED

In view of the peculiar circumstances surrounding the purported interment of Orrin W. Thorson, 0-773887, and the fact that personnel directly connected with the interment are no longer on duty in this Theater, I recommend that additional investigation be conducted in the ZI in an effort to clarify this case.
