

Your letter pertaining to the remains of your son, the late Private Paul D. Andes, has come to my attention.

The official report of burial indicates that the remains of your son were originally interred in the vicinity in which he died, but were later disinterred and moved to a more appropriate location where constant care and protection could be given our honored dead.

The remains of your son are now interred in Grave 5243, in the United States Armed Forces Cemetery, Leyte #1, located just outside the town of Palo, approximately eight miles south of Tacloban, Leyte Island, Philippine Islands.

The Department of the Army may only legally recognize designations for disposition of the remains of your son, from persons in strict agreement with the precedence among relatives established by the Secretary of the Army. The present records of the Department of the Army indicate that your son's widow now has the sole right to designate the disposition. In the absence of special circumstances the Department of the Army will comply with all her feasible desires.

She may exercise that right unless relinquished or voided by special circumstances approved by the Department of the Army. In either event the right will pass to the father of the decedent who is next in line of eligibility.

Since the "Request for Disposition of Remains" form has not been sent to your son's widow, her desires in this matter are not yet of official record in this office.







Dear Mr. and Mrs. Andes:

Your letter of recent date has been forwarded to this office for direct reply, relative to the return of the remains of your son, the late Private Paul D. Andes, to the United States for final interment.

At the outbreak of the war it became necessary for the War Department to adopt the policy that no remains of our deceased military personnel will be returned to the United States for final interment until after the cessation of hostilities in all theaters of operation. This office upon termination of the war will inquire regarding the wishes of the legal next of kin as to the final disposition of the remains.

A notation has been made on the official records of this office that it is your desire to have the remains of your son returned to Timberville, Virginia, for final interment in the Andes Cemetery, after the war. However, this office cannot at this time assure you that it will be possible to return your son's remains, as to date a report of interment has not been received.

An effort is being made to obtain a report covering the disposition of your son's remains and upon receipt of such information you will be advised.

Due to the fact that this office has a tremendous volume of correspondence relating to information regarding our deceased military personnel, it was not possible to answer your letter promptly. However, you may be assured that this office is endeavoring to reply to incoming correspondence as it is received.

Please accept my sincere sympathy in the loss of your son.
